Discount for Contaminated Oats

Oats found to contain substances poisonous to humans or animals, such as mercurial compounds and toxin-producing molds, will receive a discount equal to the settlementvalue determined after applying all other premiums and discounts.

- **Exception:** For oats delivered to CCC and the warehouse receipt indicates avomitoxin level of:
 - 5 parts per million or less, determine the settlement rate in thenormal manner
 - more than 5 parts per million, the oats shall have a settlement value of **zero**.
