ABCs of Rural Development



Affordable Housing

Funding for homeownership loans and rental complexes.



Business and Economic Development

Funding for Technical Assistance, Business Start Up, Marketing and Feasibility Studies.



Community Infrastructure

Funding for the bricks and mortar of infrastructure needs in a community.

Business & Cooperative Programs

- Business & Industry (B&I) Loan Guarantee
- Intermediary Relending Program (IRP)
- Rural Business Development Grant (RBDG)
- Rural Economic Development Loan/Grant (REDLG)
- Value-Added Agricultural Producer Grant (VAPG)
- Rural Energy for America Program



Business Programs

- Business & Industry Loan Guarantees
 - Business development, growth, modernization, conversion, or repair
 - Purchase and develop land, Buy and develop land, buildings, and associated infrastructure for commercial or industrial use
 - Purchase equipment, machinery, supplies, or inventory



Value Added Producer Grants (VAPG)

- Funding available for either
 - Planning Grants \$75,000 max
 - Feasibility Study & Business Plans
 - Working Capital \$250,000 max
 - Processing costs
 - Marketing and advertising expenses
 - Some inventory and salary expenses

Eligible Applicants

- Independent Producers
- Agricultural Producer Groups
- Farmer- or Rancher Cooperatives
- Majority-controlled Producer

• Matching Requirement:

- 1-to-1 match (50% of total project costs) cash or eligible in-kind contributions to be used only for eligible project purposes
- Grant Period:
 - Up to 36 months



Rural Energy for America Program (REAP)

- Grant Funds up to 50% of Total Eligible Project Costs
- Quarterly Competitions through 9/30/2024
- Renewable Energy Systems or Energy Efficiency Improvements
- Rural Small Businesses or Ag Producers

Renewable Energy Systems		Energy Efficiency Improvements	
Minimum Grant Request	\$2,500 Total eligible project costs > \$6,250	Minimum Grant Request	\$1,500 Total eligible project costs > \$3,750
Maximum Grant Request	\$1,000,000 Total eligible project costs > \$2.5 million	Maximum Grant Request	\$500,000 Total eligible project costs > \$1.2.5 million



Upcoming Application Deadlines



Funded Project 1



- Commercial Building
- 26.5kW PV Solar Awnings
- 54,003kWh Annual Production

- 100% Offset of historical
- \$7,744 annual savings

Funded Project 2



- 25kW Hydro Turbine
- Existing irrigation ditch
- 43,000kW production during irrigation season
- Savings of \$6,000/annually
- Offset 100% of historical
- Collaboration with Colorado Department of Agriculture


