

2024 Important Dates

Funding

Marketing Assistance Loans (MALs)

- January 31: Deadline to request MAL for prior year harvested wool, mohair, and Loan Deficiency Payment (LDP) for unshorn pelts.
- March 31: Deadline to request MAL for prior year harvested wheat, barley, canola, crambe, flaxseed, honey, oats, rapeseed, and sesame.
- May 31: Deadline to request MAL for prior year harvested corn, cotton, soybeans and other oilseeds, rice, grain sorghum, and pulse crops.

Farm Storage Facility Loans (FSFL)

Applications are accepted year-round.

 Contact your local FSA office early in the planning process to determine what level of environmental review is required for your program application so that it can be completed timely.

Farm Loan Programs (FLP)

Applications are accepted year-round.

- Beginning Farmer Loans
- Farm Operating Loans
- Farm Ownership Loans
- Microloans (\$50,000 and under)
- Youth Loans

Livestock Indemnity Program (LIP)

 Retroactive for 2023 and moving forward, a Notice of Loss must be completed by the eligible producer no later than the program application date, which is 60 calendar days following the program year in which the loss occurred.

Livestock Forage Program (LFP)

 January 30: Final deadline to submit Application for Payment for 2023 losses.

Emergency Assistance for Livestock, Honeybees and Farm-Raised Fish Program (ELAP)

 The final date to file a Notice of Loss and submit an Application for Payment is 30 calendar days following the program year in which the loss occurred.

Noninsured Crop Disaster Assistance Program (NAP) Closing Deadlines

- February 1: Onions.
- March 15: Spring-seeded annual crops and sage.
- May 31: Ornamental and non-ornamental nursery crops.
- November 20: Apples, aronia, blueberries, caneberries, cherries, cranberries, elderberries, gooseberries, grapes, hopes, juneberries, pears, and plums.
- December 31: Honey and maple sap.

Acreage reporting, or certification, is an important part of determining eligibility for programs.

- July 15: Deadline for annual certification of beans, grass seed, perennial forage, and all other spring-seeded crop acreage.
- November 15: Deadline for annual certification of fall-seeded grains and RMA insured apiculture.
